Authorized Tour Requirements:

- Tours must be requested <u>at least</u> one month in advance; the earlier, the better to ensure calendar availability as we are only able to schedule no more than three tours per month and no more than one per week.
- \circ Tours must be requested to take place on a duty day and within duty hours 0730-1630; no weekend or holiday tours. One day tours only.
- Tour groups must consist of 20-40 individuals. No exceptions. Most facilities on base, to include busses, cannot accommodate more than 40 people.
- Groups must pay for their meals and coordinate lodging. Contact information below:

- Groups must specify the school grade of the attendees for our planning purposes.
- In some cases, 1 SOW/PA will take photos during the tour if required for strategic communication purposes. Generally, groups may take their own photos during the tour unless instructed otherwise.
- Tour requester must go solely through the 1 SOW Public Affairs Office to make a tour request. This is to ensure Installation Commander awareness, deconfliction with other base events and proper coordination.
- Hurlburt Field Base Tours are conducted solely within the boundaries of Hurlburt Field. Requests to travel outside of the base boundaries will not be approved by our transportation busses.
