Accountability for Your Family

What is it: **Air Force Personnel Accountability and Assessment System**

- Standard method to account, assess, manage, and monitor the recovery of AF personnel and their dependents
- Provides valuable information to all levels of the Air Force chain of command
- Allows commanders to make strategic decisions which facilitate a return to stability
- Search AFPAAS in portal home screen for link to update profile, it should match DEERS
- Air Force BE READY app has good info and link to AFPAAS

- If unable to access internet, contact the UCC or AFPRC to be accounted

Family Preparedness

Have a 72 hr bag with emergency supplies, tailored to your family's needs:

- Water – 1 gal per person per day
- Food – non-perishable items
- First Aid Kit
- Radio
- Hygiene items
- Medications
- Flashlight
- Can Opener
- Extra batteries

Don't forget to have an Emergency Kit for your pet. Be sure to take your pets with you during a mandatory evacuation.
